### **C**OLLECTIONS

This term's charity is 'Friends of Whitworth House'. Whitworth House is a hostel in central Cambridge for young women who have been homeless or vulnerably housed. Whitworth House provides them with secure accommodation for up to two years and helps them to rebuild their lives and gain skills to move on and live independently.

#### RECITALS

Each Sunday during full term there is a recital in Chapel at 5.30 p.m. before Evensong. Visitors are welcome, and admission is free. The recital is a preparation for the worship to follow, and those present are invited to reflect and meditate silently during the musical offering. On Sunday 6 March the recital will feature the first performance of the winning entry of the College's 2011 Chamber Music Composition Competition.

#### Music

The Choir welcomes the Choirs of Girton and Emmanuel Colleges this term for joint services on Thursday 3 February and Tuesday 1 March respectively, and is also joined by Clare Voices for the Corporate Communion service on Sunday 13 February. A special Service of Words and Music for Lent will be given on Sunday 13 March.

In addition to the services in Chapel, the Choir also participates in three external performances of Elgar's *The Dream of Gerontius* this term, firstly in King's College Chapel with combined chapel choirs and CUMS orchestras under the direction of Sir Richard Armstrong on Saturday 22 January at 8 p.m.. The Choir then serves as the semi-chorus alongside the London Philharmonic Orchestra and Chorus under Edward Gardner in further performances at the Royal Festival Hall (Saturday 26 March, 7.30 p.m.) and in Salisbury Cathedral (Sunday 27 March).
